CANADIAN FOODGRAINS BANK (CFB)
COMMUNITY HARVEST GROWING PROJECT (CHGP)

This past year our local CHGP grew 10 acres of corn, produced a yield of 130 bushels per acre and raised \$4382.22. The combination of crop sales, support from our sponsors and generous donations from individuals allowed us to send \$16000.00 to the CFB. Every dollar worth of funding, grain or other aid committed by the CFB is matched 4:1 by CIDA, to a maximum of \$25 million per year. Across Canada last year the CFB raised \$10.5 million. As a result, \$23.7 was committed for food assistance, \$10.1 million for food security and \$2.2 million for nutrition programming in needy parts of the world. Thank you **very** much for your generous support in past years. Our parish will be supporting the CFB again this year. A presentation will be made at Kingsbridge this weekend, **July 4**, in Goderich on **July 31/August 1** and in Clinton on **September 4**. *Special collection envelopes will be found in the bulletin on the specified dates at the specified sites.*
