ST. MARTIN DE PORRES: SOCIAL JUSTICE

The St. Martin de Porres: Social Justice Committee asks that during the Lenten season food donations, to the baskets at the back of the church, are made with the St. Vincent de Paul and the Clinton Food Bank in mind. The following is a list of the items among many others that are needed; jam, cheese spread (Cheez Whiz), mayonnaise, canned fruit: peaches, pears, mandarin oranges, instant coffee, sugar, shampoo, deodorant, dish soap, laundry soap, fabric softener sheets, garbage bags, powdered milk, pet food, kitty litter, new baby items, diapers (especially 2's & 3's), baby formula and baby wipes. **SHARE LENT 2010:** This year, the **Development and Peace Partner in Action** sheet features a full-colour story in drawings about the communities our Colombian partner, *Justice and Peace*, helps. During our Action campaign, we showed how the spread of agrofuel crop plantations in the Global South leads to the loss of land and livelihoods for small-scale farmers. In the Choco region of Colombia, small rural communities have been persecuted, their houses burnt to the ground, and family members assassinated to clear land for these plantations, *Justice and Peace* helps them reclaim their land and their rights. "Thanks to *Justice and Peace*, we have some peace," say community members.
